York Street Reconstruction

June 24 to November 15, 2013

The City of Toronto and TTC are replacing watermain and streetcar tracks on York Street between Queen St. W. and Wellington St., and on Queen St. W. from east of University Ave. to east of York St. (see map at right). Your patience during the construction period is crucial and appreciated.

Construction Work includes:

- Replacement of watermain and service connections
- Installing new streetcar tracks
- Road reconstruction and resurfacing
- Sidewalk repairs
- Upgrading traffic signals

Traffic Restrictions

During construction, traffic on York St. from Wellington St. W. to Queen St. W. will be **limited to only one lane (north direction)**.

Work Hours

Heavy Construction work will typically take place from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. from Monday to Friday, and from 9 a.m. to 7 p.m. on weekends. However, the TTC track reconstruction phase of this project will involve periods of late evening and overnight work and extended weekend hours. Efforts will be made to make any related water disruption seamless by scheduling service connections at night.

Disruptions

As with all construction projects, there will be noise, dust and other inconveniences. In order to complete the work effectively and in a safe manner, some pedestrian and traffic restrictions will be necessary.

During heavy construction, there will be restrictions to turning, parking and driving lanes in and around the work area.

Access and Recycling and Garbage Collection

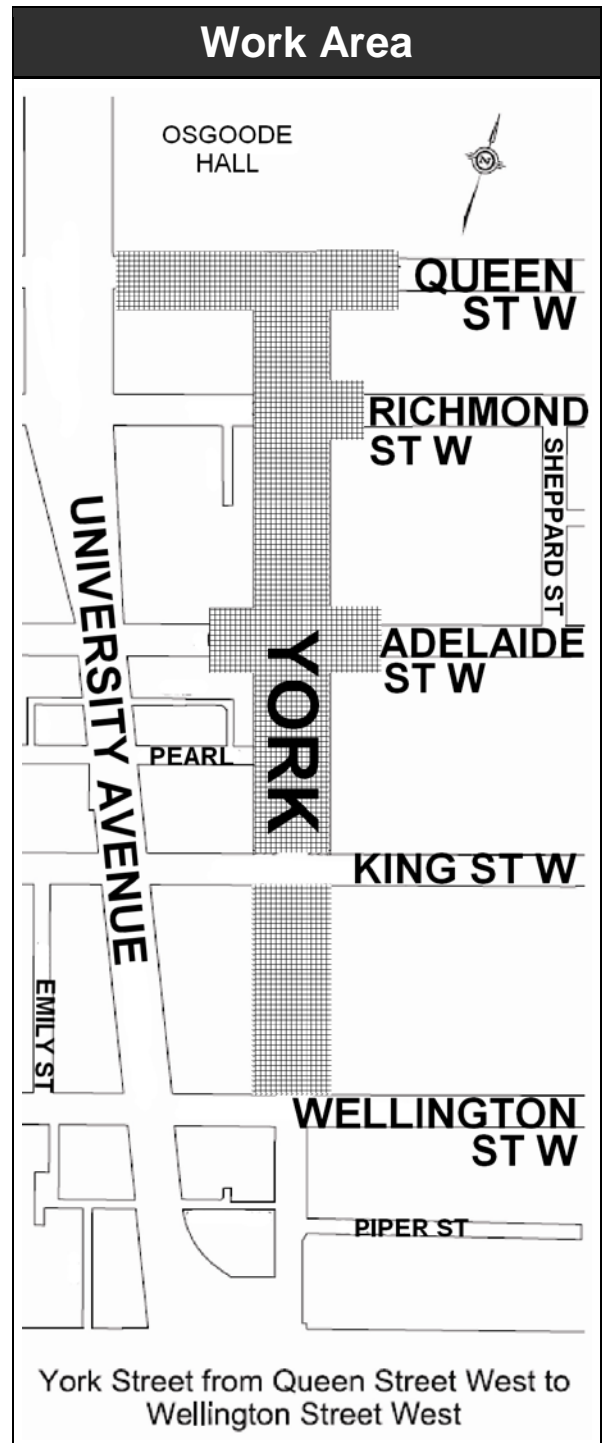
Access to driveways will be coordinated and maintained as best as possible. Please follow your normal routine.

The following intersection closures are required to complete construction. On-site signage will be posted. Dates are current as of printing and may change due to unforeseen events.

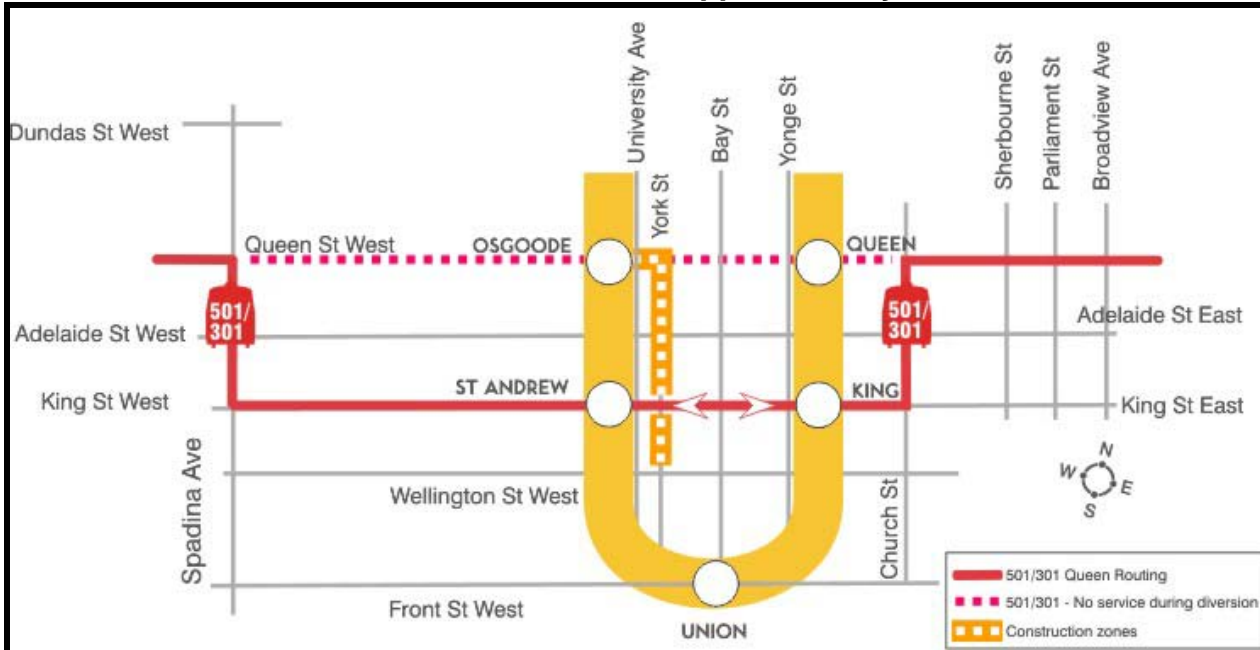
Street	Length of Closure	Details
Queen St. W.	June 29 – July 12, 2013	One westbound lane will be open for traffic. Eastbound traffic will detour at University Avenue to Adelaide Street.
Richmond St. W.	July 27 – August 4, 2013	Complete closure.
Adelaide St. W.	August 24 – August 31, 2013	Complete closure.
Pearl St.	Will be announced in following construction notice	Complete closure for 96 hours.



TTC Service Changes

501/301 Queen Route: Beginning Saturday June 29 for approximately two weeks, streetcars will be diverted both ways via: Church St., King St. W. and Spadina Ave. to accommodate track and road work on Queen St. W. from University Ave. to just east of York St.

501/301 QUEEN - Effective June 29, 2013 for approximately 2 weeks



The following TTC routes will also be diverted as construction progresses south on York Street. The routings will be posted at transit stops along affected routes advising of the diversions as well as posted on the TTC website.

Downtown Express bus routes (141, 142, 143, 144 and 145) buses will be diverted when construction reaches the York-Richmond and York-Adelaide intersections.

503 Kingston Road streetcars will be diverted when construction reaches the section between King St. W. and Wellington St. Streetcars will operated both ways on King St. W. to Spadina Ave. looping via Adelaide St. and Charlotte St.
