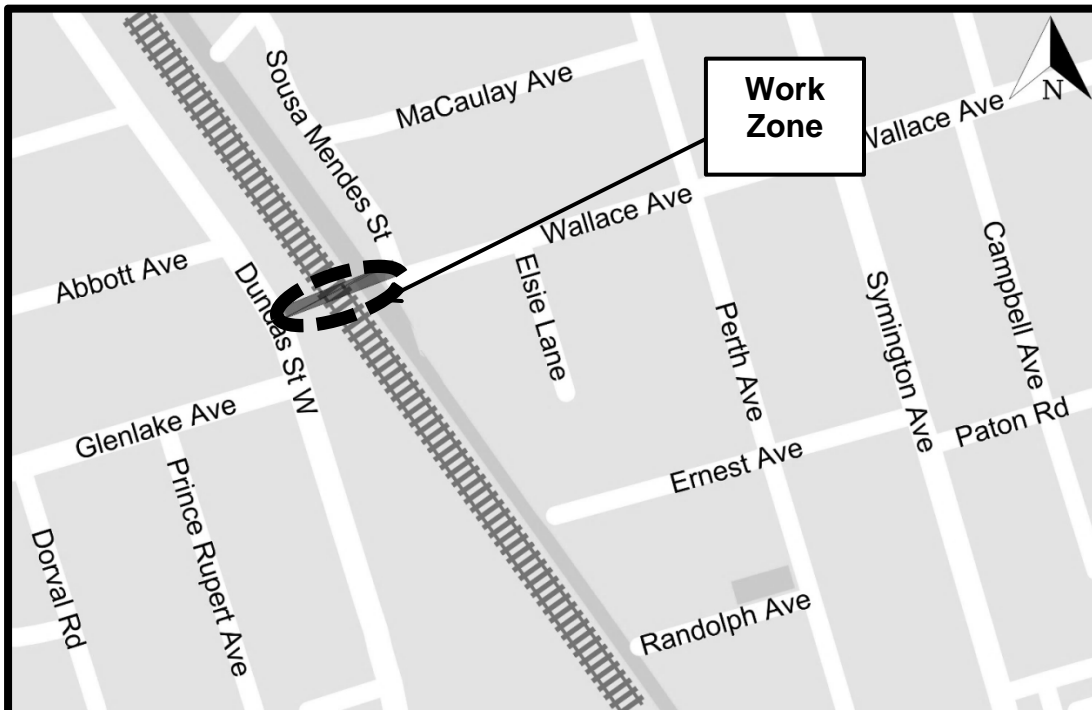
Expected Start Date: November 21, 2016

The contractor will:

- Remove the installed temporary security fences along the entire bridge.
- Install improved railing along the entire bridge

	<p><b>Nightly Work Hours:</b> 10 pm to 6 am Monday, November 21 to Wednesday, November 24 The bridge will be open on Wednesday, November 24<sup>th</sup>, 6 am.</p>
	<p><b>Bridge and Pathway Access:</b> In order to complete the work in a safe manner, the bridge will be closed during the time specified.</p>
	<p><b>Traffic Management:</b> Traffic should not be impacted by this work.</p>
	<p><b>Restoration:</b> The construction work area will be restored before 6 am every morning for pedestrian access.</p>
