

Infrastructure Improvements in 2017

The Queensway, Lake Shore Boulevard West and Humber Loop

Work description and purpose

The City of Toronto and TTC are coordinating a number of infrastructure improvement projects along the west end of the 501/301 Queen Streetcar route in 2017. Buses will replace streetcars between Roncesvalles Avenue and Long Branch Loop starting on January 8, throughout 2017.

Construction projects include:

- Bridge Rehabilitation – The Queensway Bridge over the Humber River
- Track renewal on The Queensway from Parkside Drive to Humber Loop
- Track replacement on Lake Shore Boulevard from Humber Loop to Dwight Avenue
- Humber Loop Improvements: new accessible platforms, new shelters, new rails, roofing replacement, new electrical substation to protect the long term integrity of rails on Lake Shore Blvd West

(Preliminary overhead wire and rail welding work west of Parkside Drive will begin in January, 2017, weather permitting). ***Traffic lane restrictions required to complete the projects are anticipated to begin in March, 2017. Additional construction details will be provided.**

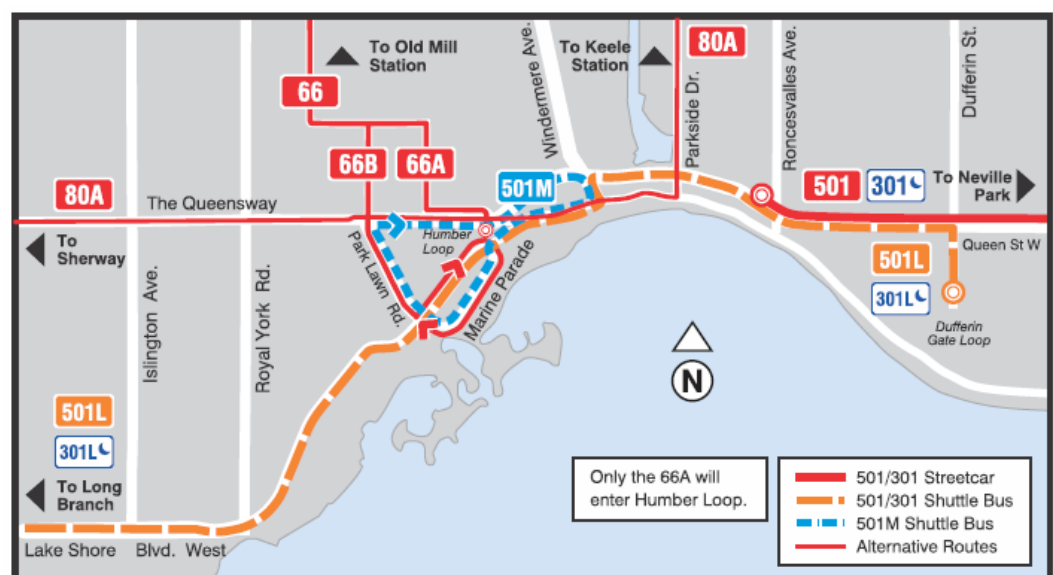
TTC service changes (January 8, 2017 and continuing through the year)

Buses will temporarily replace streetcars west of Roncesvalles Avenue, on The Queensway and Lake Shore Boulevard, and will bypass Humber Loop.

- **501/301 Queen** streetcars will operate between Roncesvalles Avenue, downtown, and Neville Park Loop.
- **501L/301L Queen** buses will operate between Dufferin Street (Dufferin Gate Loop) and Long Branch Loop, via Queen Street, The Queensway, Windermere Avenue, and Lake Shore Boulevard.
- **501M Queen – (during construction)** will operate clockwise linking The Queensway with Lake Shore Boulevard, Marine Parade Drive, and Park Lawn Road.
- **80A Queensway** buses will operate along The Queensway and Parkside Drive to Keele Station, all day, every day. **66B Prince Edward** buses will continue to provide service on Lake Shore Boulevard and Marine Parade, all day, every day.

Customers can transfer between streetcars and buses at any point between Dufferin Street and Roncesvalles Avenue. When transferring between 501/301 Queen streetcars and buses using PRESTO, please do not tap onto the next vehicle when boarding.
