

The Queensway - **Update** Parkside Drive to Windermere Avenue Rail installation begins

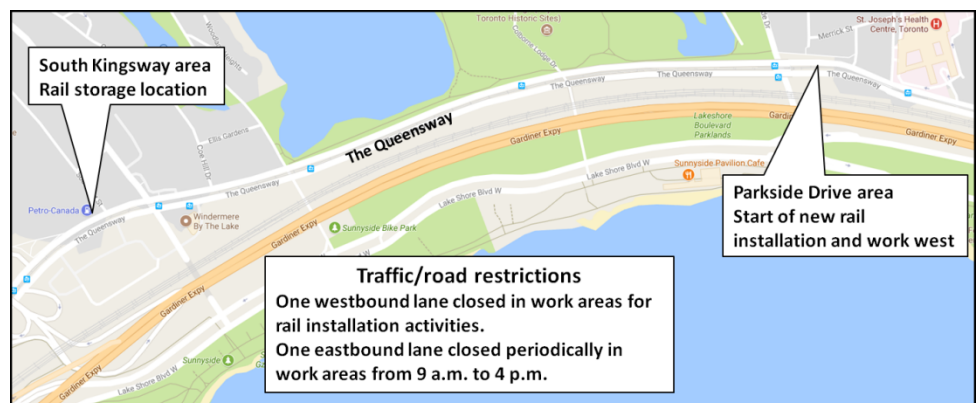
Work for The Queensway Track project from Parkside Drive to Windermere Avenue has reached a point where the installation of new rail can now begin.

New rail installation

The new rail that is presently stored on The Queensway track corridor west of Windermere Avenue will be moved/pulled as required to the east end of the work for installation as work progresses in a westerly fashion. Due to the potential safety risk resulting from the high volumes of traffic and pedestrian movement in the Windermere Avenue area, moving the rail strings to the east end of the work limits for installation will take place between approximately 11 p.m. and 5 a.m.

Traffic/road restrictions

During periods when the rail strings are being moved from the storage area to the installation area, one westbound traffic lane on The Queensway will be closed from South Kingsway to just east of Parkside Drive. During other times, the westbound lane closure will be shortened to the length of the work zone areas. Periodically, one eastbound lane will be closed in work areas from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.



Work Hours

Rail installation by TTC track crews **will involve periods of late evening and overnight work.** The overnight rail work by TTC may consist of moving rail into position, rail installation/assembly and rail welding / grinding. After-hours work by TTC is required to support the daytime construction and complete the project on schedule.
