

## Temporary bus looping on local streets 506 Carlton route Howard Park Avenue and Ritchie Avenue

**Date:** September 2 to October 6, 2018

Content/timeline accurate at time of printing

### Description and purpose

Since mid-February TTC operated a bus service in place of streetcars on the 506 Carlton route. These changes were necessary to provide uninterrupted service during numerous road construction projects along the route, including major work at Main Street Station, the east end terminus for the 506 Carlton route.

### TTC Service

#### Return of 506 Carlton streetcars and bus supplement

Starting September 2, streetcar service will be restored to the 506 Carlton route. Due to the number of streetcars available for service we are supplementing the morning peak period streetcar service with a number of weekday bus trips during a two-hour peak period (Monday to Friday – 8 a.m. and 10 a.m.); approximately eight trips/hour.

The Carlton buses will loop at Main Street Station in the east end of the route. In the west end of the route buses cannot be accommodated inside TTC's High Park Loop so the buses will loop via the Lansdowne Triangle -- (west on College Street, south on Lansdowne Avenue, west on Dundas Street and east on College Street).

#### Temporary bus diversion (September 2 to October 6)

During the period from September 2 to October 6, the City and TTC will be replacing the streetcar tracks at the intersection of Dundas and Lansdowne requiring alternate routing of the Carlton buses. During this period and to maintain a reliable morning peak service to customers on the route the following turn-back looping will be used; Buses will loop one-way via; **north/west on Dundas Street, west on Howard Park Avenue, north on Roncesvalles Avenue, north/east on Ritchie Avenue and east on Dundas Street.** See map below

As soon as the track work at the intersection of Dundas and Lansdowne is complete and reopened to traffic, the supplementary buses will loop via the Lansdowne Triangle noted above.

We regret any inconvenience that may be caused as a result of this necessary bus routing.
