
### What does this trail mean for you?

# Trail Alignment and Project Area

An Environmental Assessment study was completed in Spring 2016 and determined the preferred trail alignment and location of access points to local streets. The preferred alignment was determined in coordination with Metrolinx because most of the Railpath Extension is located within the Metrolinx owned rail corridor.
