REMINDER: Upcoming Bridge Maintenance Work at Windermere Ave.

November 2018

THE PROJECT

From **November 23 to November 26** Metrolinx will be rehabilitating the rail bridge that runs over **Windermere Avenue**. The work will start Friday evening around 8:00 p.m. and continue around the clock until the following Monday morning.

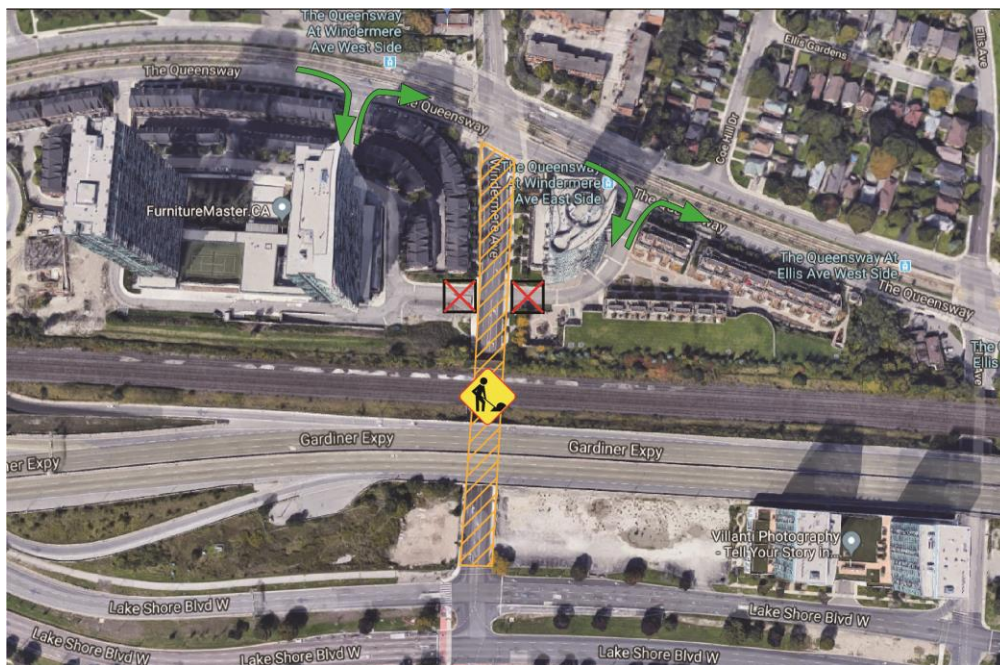
This work is part of a broader project where Metrolinx is rehabilitating/replacing 6 century-old rail bridges over the course of 9 weekends.

WHAT TO EXPECT

We recognize that railway work can be disruptive and we are doing our best to minimize the amount of disruption to our customers and nearby communities. Due to the complexity of these projects, weekend work will take place around the clock.

Residents and businesses in the neighbourhood surrounding the bridge may notice:

- **A full closure of Windermere Ave. within the work area between The Queensway and Lakeshore Blvd.** (signage will be displayed at street level in advance of the closure).
- **No access to the entrance ways off of Windermere Ave., as shown on the map below.**
 - To access your property you must be traveling eastbound on The Queensway.
 - To access the Gardiner Expressway you can make a U-Turn at Windermere Ave. or Ellis Ave. and use the South Kingsway on-ramp.
 - To access Lakeshore Boulevard you can travel south on Ellis Ave.
- **Night-time construction noise and lighting.**
