Background:

Dwelling rooms in rooming houses are an important part of Toronto's affordable housing landscape. As the city grows, development is placing pressure on the stock of existing dwelling rooms. The City of Toronto is proposing a draft Official Plan Amendment with new policies to address the loss of dwelling rooms to development and the displacement of tenants who rent them. The policies would require the same amount of dwelling room gross floor area to be replaced as rental housing in the new development and assistance provided to displaced tenants.
