End Date: December 22, 2018

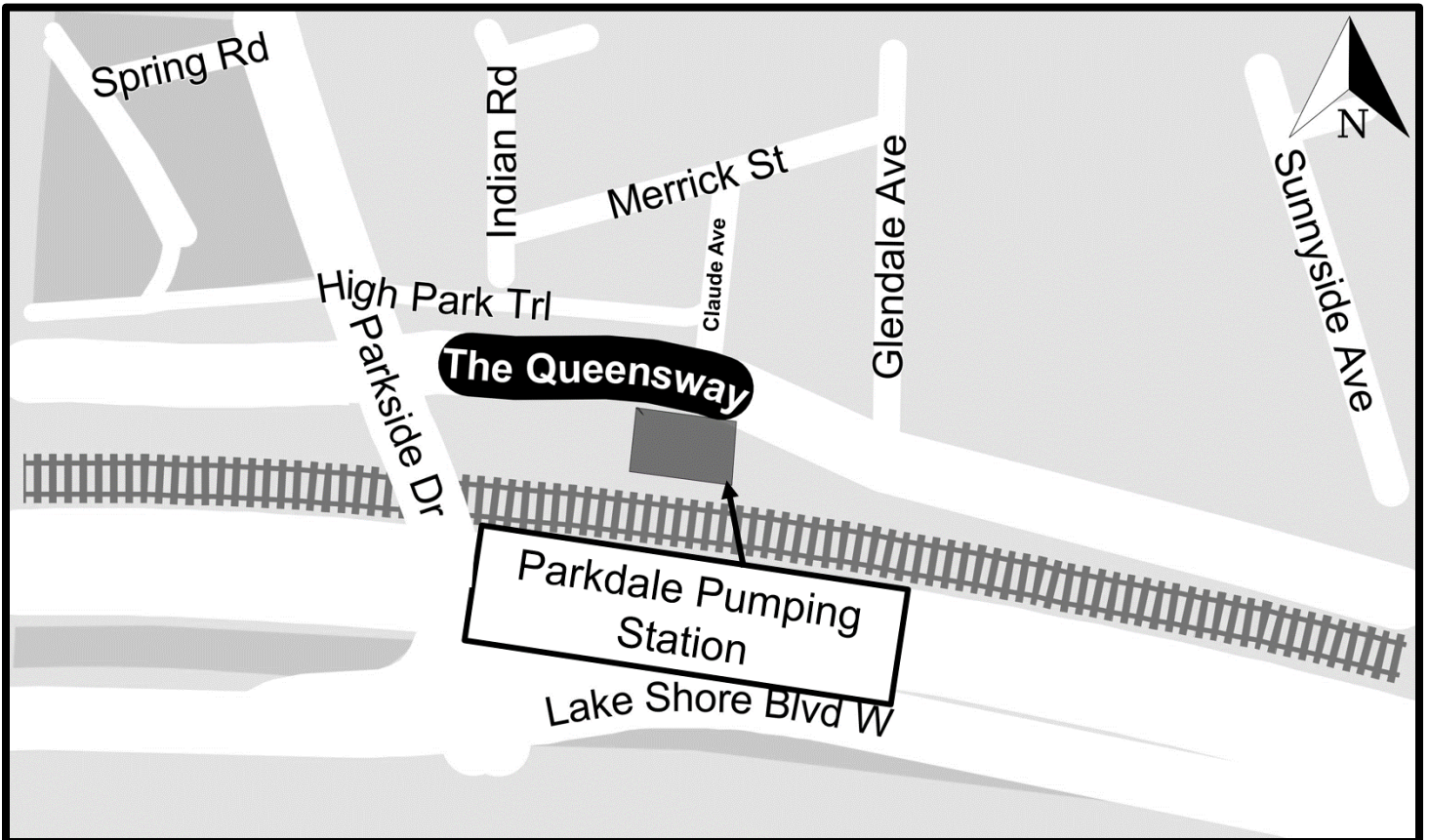
The City of Toronto is renewing the aging flow meters at the Parkdale Pumping Station located at 71 The Queensway (east of Parkside Drive). In order to complete this work, one lane of the Queensway is needed in order to access chambers within the roadway.

This project is part of the Council-approved 2018 Capital Works Program to renew our aging infrastructure and improve water distribution.

TRAFFIC IMPACTS

	<p>Traffic Management: Efforts have been made to manage traffic in the area for the safety of workers, road users and residents. Road users should expect delays and increased traffic at peak hours.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Eastbound traffic on the Queensway will be reduced to one lane of traffic from November 12 to December 22. • Westbound traffic on the Queensway will not be affected.
	<p>Work Hours: Work will take place from 7:00 am to 3:30 pm., Monday to Friday, with work after hours and on weekends as required. The lane closure will remain in place for the duration of the work.</p>
	<p>Pedestrians: The south sidewalk adjacent to the pumping station will be closed; pedestrians are advised to use the sidewalk on the north side of the Queensway in this area. Please abide by signage.</p>
	<p>Cyclists: If travelling on the eastbound Queensway, please share the traffic lane in the active work zone.</p>
	<p>Restoration: Areas affected by construction will be restored.</p>
