

Between Keele and Dundas West stations Subway track maintenance - tamping

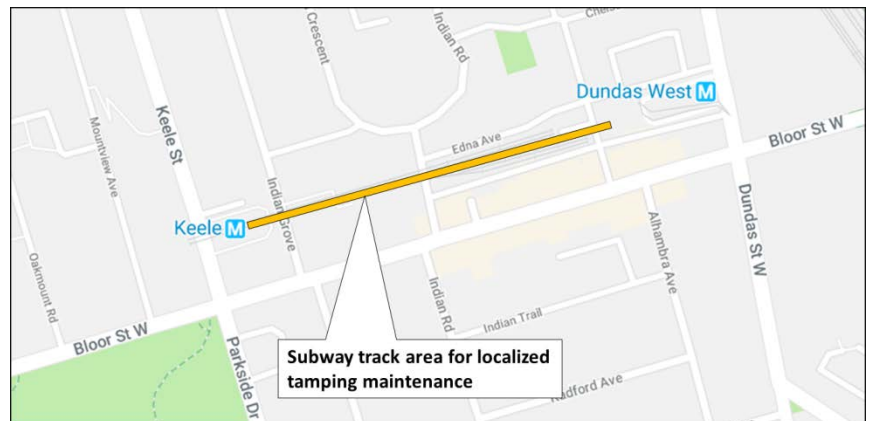
Dates: November 6 to 9, 2018 (2 a.m. to 5:30 a.m.) **Overnight work**

Work description and purpose

Starting on Tuesday, November 6 after Monday subway service ends, a track crew will be working overnight between Keele and Dundas West stations to conduct essential track maintenance. The work will involve tamping areas of track between the two stations. The overnight maintenance activity will also occur on Wednesday and Thursday nights.

As part of TTC's preventative and corrective maintenance program, tamping is carried out to maintain proper support by the ballast (stone) foundation that secures the track in place and helps provide for a smoother operation through the track area. Tamping can only be conducted when subway service is not running.



Additional work*

If necessary, the crew will return a fourth night to complete any remaining tamping work.

Equipment

A crew will be using a work car and portable hydraulic tampers to complete the work. While efforts will be made to keep noise levels to a minimum, some noise will be unavoidable when the work-car is in full operation.
