## Dundas West Station Essential subway drainage maintenance

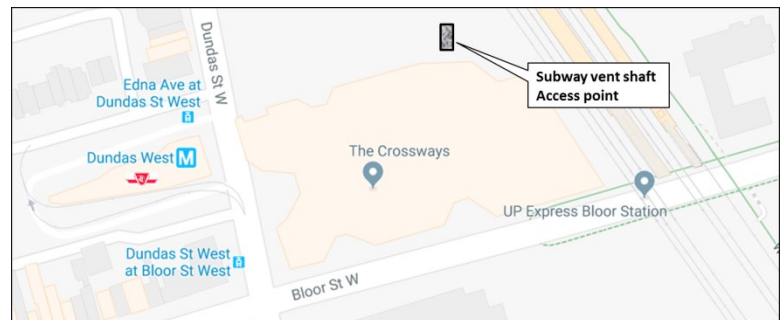
### Work description and purpose

Essential maintenance work will be carried out to the subway sewer/drainage system in the vicinity of Dundas West Station. The maintenance work is to ensure proper drainage is maintained along this tunnel where the Emergency Tunnel Fans are situated.

TTC has contracted the use of a high-pressure water system mounted on a truck to carry out this work at track level. This method of removing the obstruction and residue from the drainage system is efficient and quick. Noise will be evident when work is in full operation.

### Point of Access

The truck will be parked at street level at the rear of “The Crossways” next to a subway vent shaft. The water hose will be lowered from the truck at street level into the vent shaft through an access opening in the metal grate. This is the nearest access point to the drainage system where the hose from the truck will be safely guided through.



### Work hours

For the safety of the crew, the work must be done when the subway is not running. The crew will be onsite at 1:30 a.m. on Saturday, November 10 for set-up. Work will begin shortly after Friday subway service ends. The work will be completed by approximately before regular Saturday subway service begins.
