Dwelling rooms in rooming houses are an important part of Toronto's affordable housing landscape. As the city grows, development is placing pressure on the stock of existing dwelling rooms. The City has been working to develop Official Plan policies to address the loss of dwelling rooms to development and the displacement of tenants who rent them. Consultations were undertaken in late 2018 to provide information and obtain feedback on the draft policies from the public and stakeholders. City Planning has revised the draft policies based on the feedback received through the consultations, as well as additional analysis and consultation with other City Divisions.

Join us on Monday, May 6, 2019 at an Open House consultation on the proposed revisions to the draft policies. This is your opportunity to provide feedback and ask questions of City staff. You are welcome to attend at any time during the open house.
